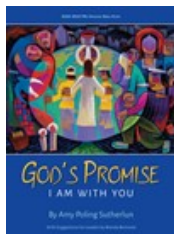

This 12-week study provides reflective questions as follows:

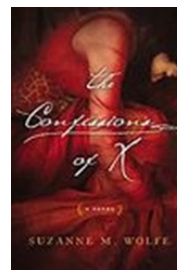
