How can I fulfill my pledge commitment to the First Presbyterian Church of Plymouth?

We want to make it as easy as possible for you to give in the way that is most convenient for your situation. We offer a number of giving options. For information about each of these, visit fpcp.net/give.

• Give Online

Vanco Online giving is a fast, easy and secure way to make one-time or reoccurring payments. Online giving allows for a specific dollar amount of your choosing to be automatically deducted from a bank or a debit or credit card account. Follow the link on the fpcp.net/give web page to use this tool.

• Give by App

Go to the App Store or Google Play and search for **Vanco Mobile** to download the free app, then select our church, "**First Presbyterian Church of Plymouth**". If you have previously used the Vanco Online web page, you already have an account. Otherwise, set up an account using your email address and a password. Then establish one or more bank or card accounts that you wish to use and set up your first transaction. From the app, you can also view your entire online transaction history.

• Give by Text

If you wish to contribute by text message, check with Stu Dodge for the phone number to use for the new **Vanco GivePlus Text** tool. You will be sent a message (first time only) to register your personal information to complete this process, followed by a confirmation text. You will also be offered the option to set this up as a recurring payment.

• Give in Person on Sunday or By Mail

On Sundays, place cash or checks payable to FPCP (First Presbyterian Church of Plymouth) in the offering plate during any of our Sunday services. You can also mail your check to the church office (please do not send cash through the mail).

• Give by Bill Pay

Most banks now offer online bill pay services to their customers, either free of charge or for a nominal fee.

• Give Non-Cash Gifts

There can be tax benefits associated with contributions of stocks or other non-cash gifts.
