History of FPCP

The First Presbyterian Church of Plymouth first assembled in February, 1833 and officially organized with its first minister, the Rev. A.M. McJunkin, in July of 1835. That same year, the original church was built. A new brick building was built in 1849 and the original church building was sold. This building was destroyed by fire in 1936, although the Bible and church lectern survived the fire and are still on display in the church. The present structure was built in 1937, with the Chapel and educational rooms added in 1955. The building was made handicap accessible in 1992. The latest addition, completed in 2002, has provided additional classrooms and meeting rooms.
