INTERNET AND COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY POLICY

Examples of inappropriate conduct include, but are not limited to: use of inappropriate, offensive or abusive language in either public or private messages; unlawful activities; defamation; infringement of copyrights; misrepresentation of oneself or the church; logging on to or accessing pornographic, sexually explicit, violent sites or materials; accessing gambling sites; and sending messages that might result in congestion or disruption of networks and systems.
