



Is Styrofoam Recyclable???

Styrofoam is not accepted for recycling in the City of Plymouth. None of our local communities accept Styrofoam in their curbside recycling program. The following two facilities do accept styrofoam:

Recycle Ann Arbor accepts styrofoam for recycling at their Drop-Off Station. Recycle Ann Arbor's Drop-Off Station receives no funding from local government and relies on fees paid by site users to maintain the services provided. Additional fees may be charged based on what is being dropped off for recycling. Check their website for more details.

- Fee-based Recycling Drop Off (\$3/car)
- Hours: Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:30 AM - 6:30 PM, on Saturdays from 9:00 AM - 6:00 PM. They are closed on Sun., Mon., Wed., and Fri.

SOCRRA is a facility in Royal Oak that accepts Styrofoam containers but not the Styrofoam peanuts:

- Self-service Recycling Drop Off, open to the public and free of charge
- Hours: Mon – Fri 9 AM - 5 PM, Sat. 7 AM - 1 PM
