

REFILL/RECYCLE YOUR PRINTER CARTRIDGES



More than 500 million printer cartridges are sold each year in the United States, and more than half — 350 million of those — are sent to landfills. Toner/ink cartridges are both recyclable and reusable so more eco-friendly options for disposal exist. There are two main choices for keeping printer cartridges out of landfills: recycling and refilling them.

REFILL: If you want to refill your ink cartridges, you can bring them to a retailer for this service — for example, participating Walgreens and Costco stores clean and refill cartridges in the photo department for a very reasonable price.

RECYCLE: If you wish to recycle them, you may bring them to church on the first Sunday of each month. This month, the Partners in Earth Care team will take them to our local Target store for recycling.

REMEMBER also that we accept batteries for recycling on the first Sunday of each month. Batteries cannot be dropped off any other time due to fire hazard.
