Paul's letter to the church in Thessalonica is thought to be Paul's first to a church and provides one of the earliest histories of the Christian movement. Paul writes to strengthen their faith and affirm the instruction he

passed on to this fledgling church entrenched in a society of pagan worship. Paul helps them to learn the very different way of life that flows from leaving idols to serve the living and true God (1:10) where holiness is not withdrawal from the world but involvement in it in a new way marked

faith, love, and hope.
