## HAPPY BIRTHDAY, FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF PLYMOUTH

#### **CELEBRATING 188 YEARS**

On February 23, 1833, members of the community met to begin talking about starting our church. It was two years later in 1835 that the first building was constructed. That was before Michigan even became a state!

- Our first Minister, Alexander McJunkin (1835) was paid \$200.00 annually.
- It cost \$386.52, or \$11.00 per member, to build the church. It was a white frame building.
- We were initially organized under the name of "Second Presbyterian Church of Plymouth". Northville and Plymouth were part of the same community and Northville had already taken the name "First Presbyterian Church of Plymouth."
- 1849: The brick church was built.
- 1886: We became the "First Presbyterian Church of Plymouth."
- 1869: The first women were appointed to a church committee.
- 1877: The brick church was renovated.
- 1886: The first church manse was built. A new manse was built on Main Street in 1911, then sold and moved in 1982.
- 1916: An addition was added to the original brick church.
- 1936: The church burned. Rev. Nichol discovered the fire. The church lectern and Bible were found intact in the basement, which can now be found in the Tower Room.
- Services were held at the Masonic Temple until November 1937. The cornerstone was laid May 1937.
- 1950: The Presbyterian Thrift Shop started.
- 1952: A second service began.
- 1955: The tower bells were dedicated.
- 1959: Our name changed from "First Presbyterian Church of Plymouth" to the First United Presbyterian Church of Plymouth." This came about following a merger in 1958 of the Presbyterian Church USA and The United Presbyterian Church of North America.
- 1976: First woman clerk of session.
- 1983: United was dropped and we again became the "First Presbyterian Church of Plymouth."
- 2002: New addition added to the church.
- 2007: Beginning of national mission relationship with Colina De Luz orphanage.
- 2009: the Upper Room service was started.
- 2010: Beginning of international mission partnership with our sister church in Malawi.
- 2019: Emily Riley Campbell was called to serve as our Senior Minister.
- 2020: Online and parking lot services began in response to a worldwide pandemic.
- 2020: Ashley S. Ashley was called to serve as our Associate Minister.
- 2021: Indoor worship services resumed, and livestreaming began.
