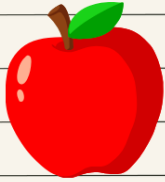

THE SECOND MILE CENTER (SMC) OF DETROIT NEEDS A MAKEOVER!

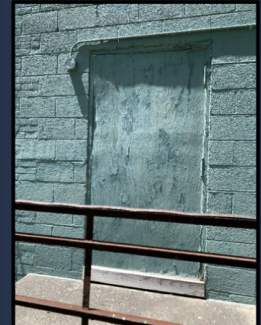
